DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAMS—REJECTION OF HIRED AUTO AND NON-OWNED AUTO COVERAGE

The commercial driving school or educational institution identified below (the "applicant") has applied for bodily injury and property damage liability insurance on only those motor vehicles specifically identified in the driving school insurance certificate filed with the California Department of Motor Vehicles. The applicant understands that it may obtain coverage for vehicles not specified in the driving school insurance certificate by paying additional premiums for hired auto and non-owned auto coverages. By signing this agreement rejecting coverage and not paying the additional premium, the applicant agrees that it is obtaining no coverage for vehicles not specified in the driving school certificate. As a result, if the applicant uses a motor vehicle in driving instruction other than a vehicle specifically identified in the driving school insurance certificate, no coverage will be provided for liability arising from the operation of the non-specified vehicle.

Hired auto and non-owned auto coverages are available to commercial driving school and educational institution applicants. This rejection of hired auto and non-owned auto coverages for non-specified vehicles is binding upon every insured to whom the bodily injury and property damage liability insurance policy applies during the period the policy is in force. This rejection shall continue to be binding through any continuation, renewal or replacement of such policy by the named insured, or during any reinstatement of the policy within thirty (30) days of its lapse.

During the term of the policy, the applicant may add hired auto and non-owned coverages for the remainder of the policy term by submitting a written request for those coverages and paying additional premiums.
